

Insurance Guide for Participating in the Space Robotics Challenge

One requirement for participation in a NASA Centennial Challenge is for teams to secure insurance for the duration of the Competition.

Per Section 6.9 of the Team Agreement, the insurance must:

- ❑ **Provide minimum claims coverage in the amount of \$100,000 USD**
- ❑ **Have a policy period of March 1, 2020 through September 30, 2021** (*Dates for participation from beginning to end of the Challenge*)
- ❑ **Insure each Challenge participant on the Team**
- ❑ **Cover all claims by a third party for death, bodily injury, or property damage, or loss resulting from an activity carried out in connection with participation in the Challenge**
- ❑ **Name the U.S. Government and the Challenge Allied Organization as additional insured parties**

- ❑ **Cover the Federal Government, the Allied Organization and all its contractors for damage or loss to Government or Allied Organization's property resulting from Challenge activities.**

If activities related to the competition will occur at a residence, Teams may wish to check with their current homeowner's insurance provider to see if the Competition activities can be covered under the current insurance policy.

If activities related to the competition will occur at a University or Corporate office, Teams may wish to contact the University or Company to see if the Competition activities can be covered under the organization's insurance.

As noted in Section 5.6 of the Team Agreement, NASA does not endorse or sponsor any commercial product, service or activity. This document does not, in any way, constitute an endorsement of any one insurance provider by any organization involved with the Space Robotics Challenge, including, but not limited to, the Allied Organization, its contractors and/or sponsors, NASA or the U.S. Government.

Competitors are required to perform their own due diligence when contracting with any insurance provider. None of the organizations involved in the Space Robotics Challenge will be held responsible for any difficulties encountered when entering into a contract with any insurance provider.
